FERPA: The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act

The law applies to all institutions of higher education which receive funds under applicable programs of the U.S. Department of Education. With limited exceptions, Sul Ross State University must have a signed acknowledgment from you before personal information can be released to a third party (i.e. spouse, parent, employer, etc.).
