

Guidelines for Innovation Grant 2022

Description

Each spring academic and administrative program coordinators may apply for an Innovation Grant offered through the Office of Institutional Effectiveness. These grants will enable program coordinators to upgrade, enhance, or refine their existing program designs. Proposals may address funding for faculty or staff participation in analyzing assessment, purchasing equipment and materials, attending conferences, etc. Grants of up to \$1000 will be awarded in May.

Rationale

SACSCOC core requirement 7.1 requires the institution to engage in “ongoing, comprehensive, and integrated, research-based planning and evaluation processes that (a) Focus on institutional quality and effectiveness and (b) Incorporate a systematic review of institutional goals and outcomes consistent with its mission.” The grant is designed for continuous improvement of SRSU’s academic and administrative programs.

Time line

March 2- April 24	Complete the application
May	Review of proposals by Academic and Administrative Advisory Committee
May 15	Award of selected proposals with designated budget account
June-January	Implementation of proposals
February 3	Completion of project and submission of final report
